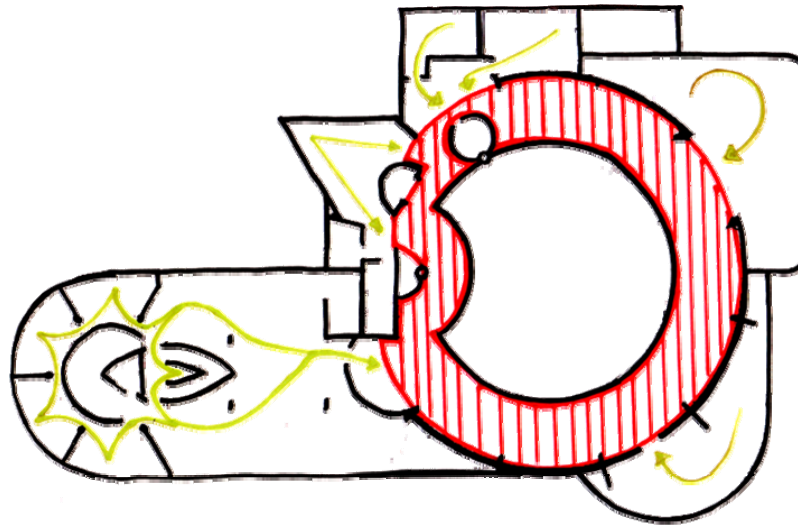




Ruimtelijke relaties

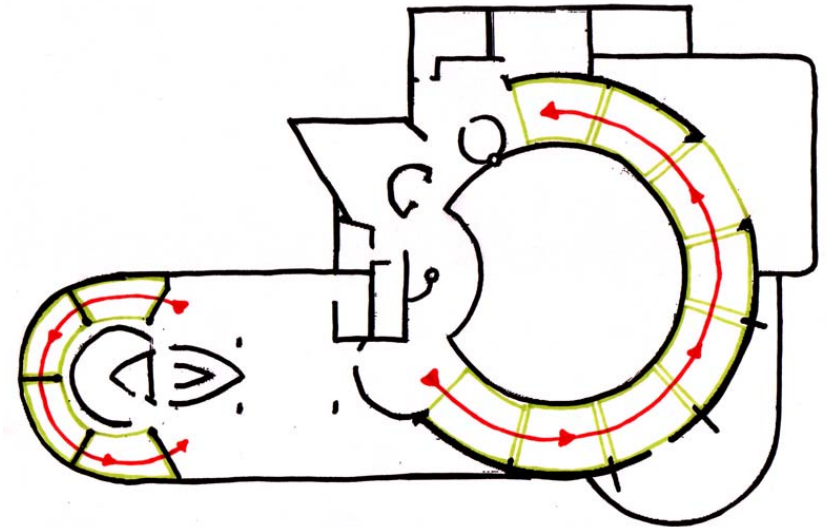
1. Space within space
2. Interlocking spaces
3. Adjacent spaces
4. Spaces linked by a common space





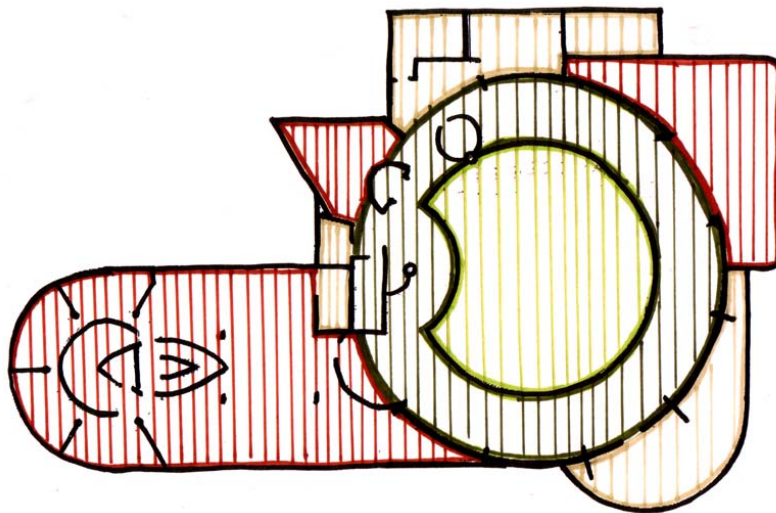
A. Centralized organisation

A central, dominant space about which a number of secondary spaces are grouped.



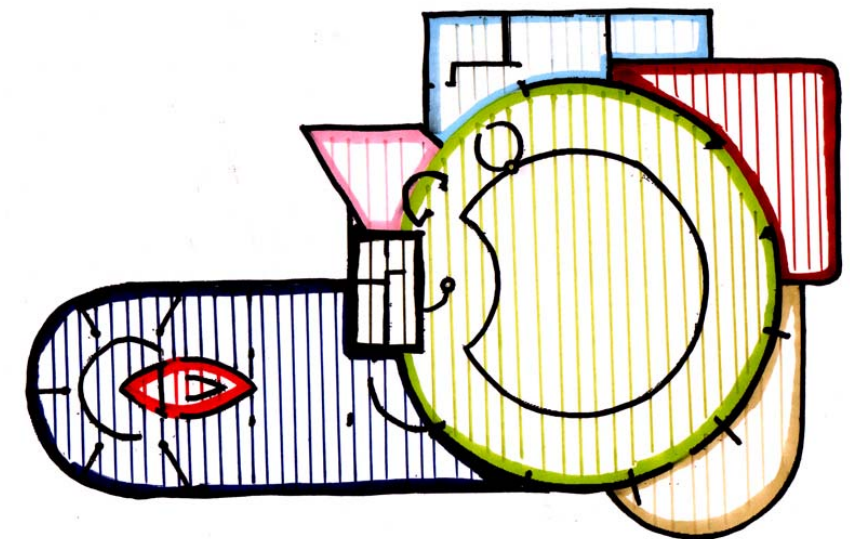
B. Linear organisation

A linear sequence of repetitive spaces.



C. Radial organisation

A central space from which linear organisations of space extend in a radial manner.

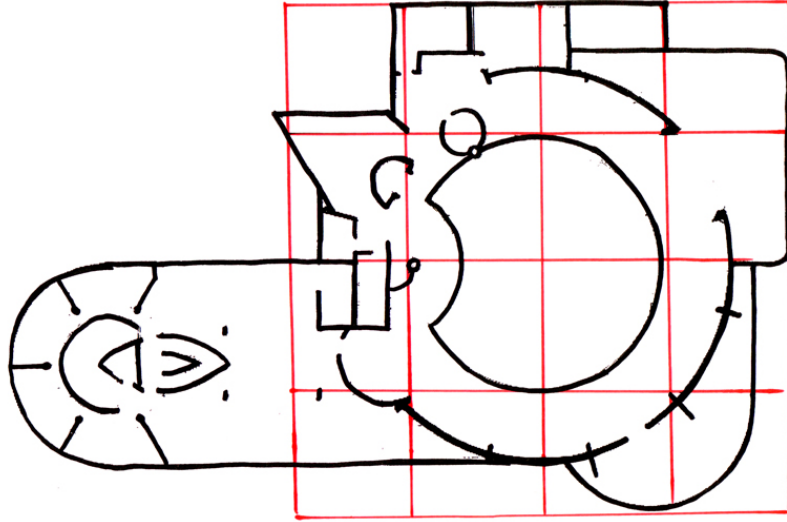


D. Clustered organisation

Space grouped by proximity or the sharing of a common visual trait or relationship.

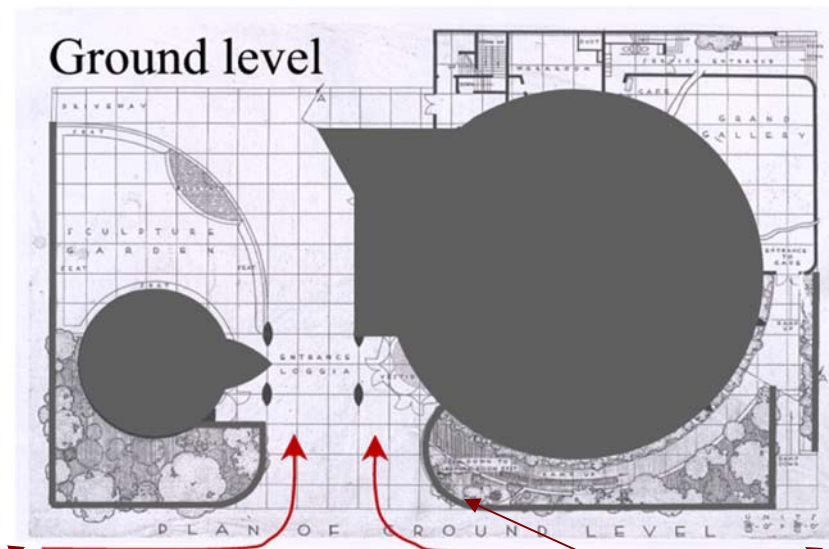


E. Grid organisation

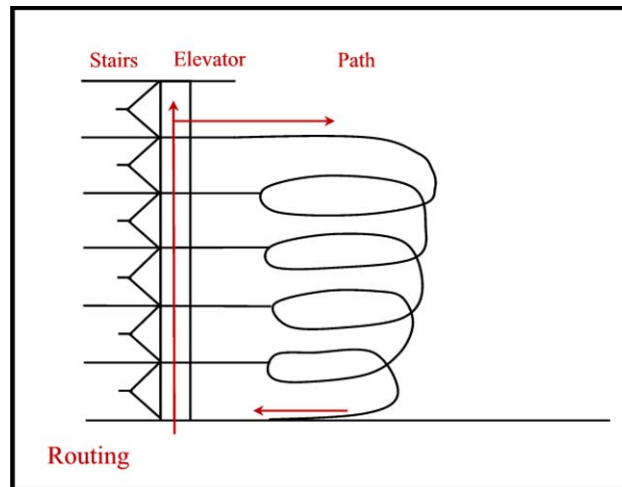

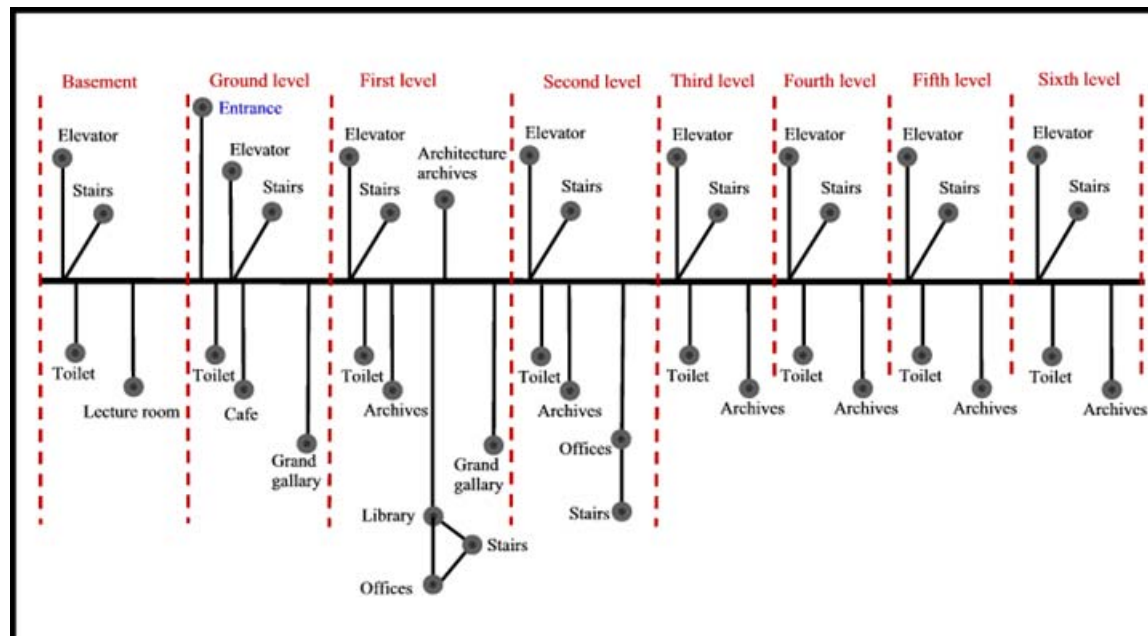




Configuration of the path

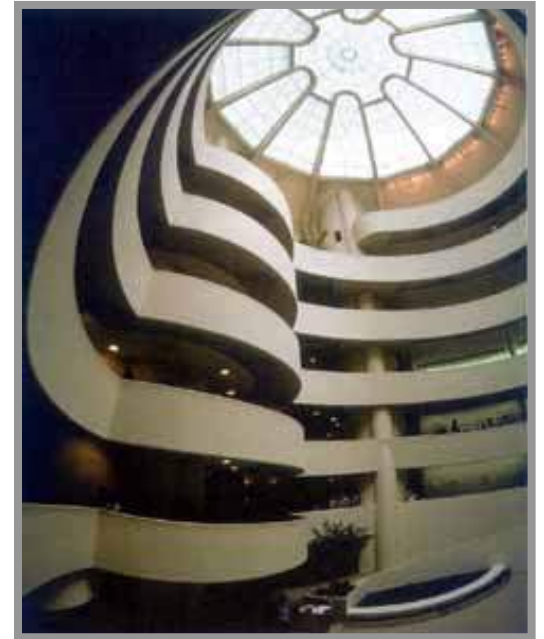


Path/space relationships



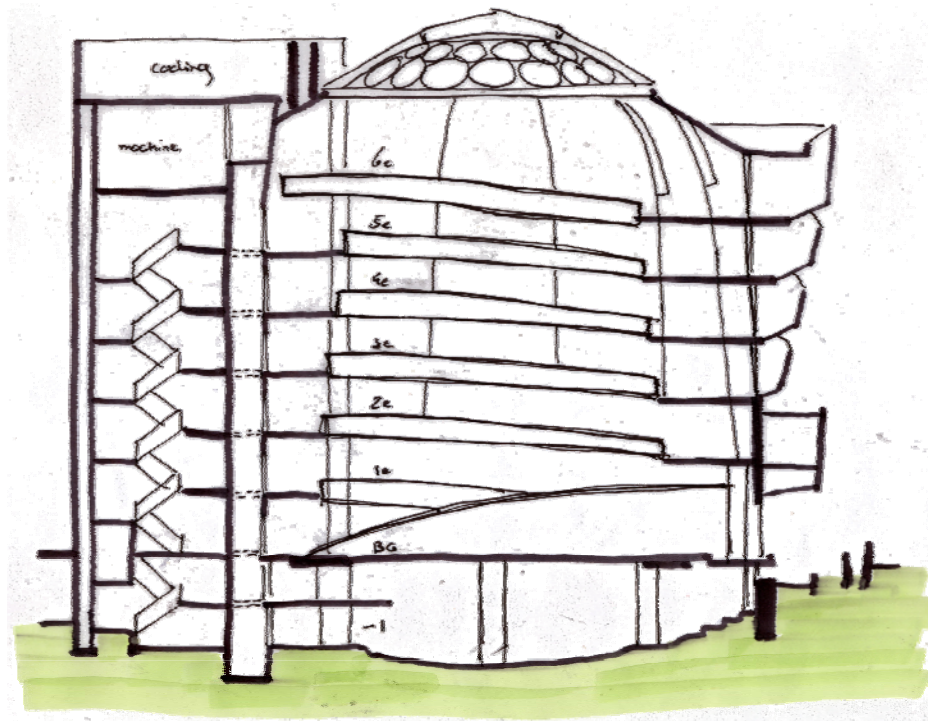
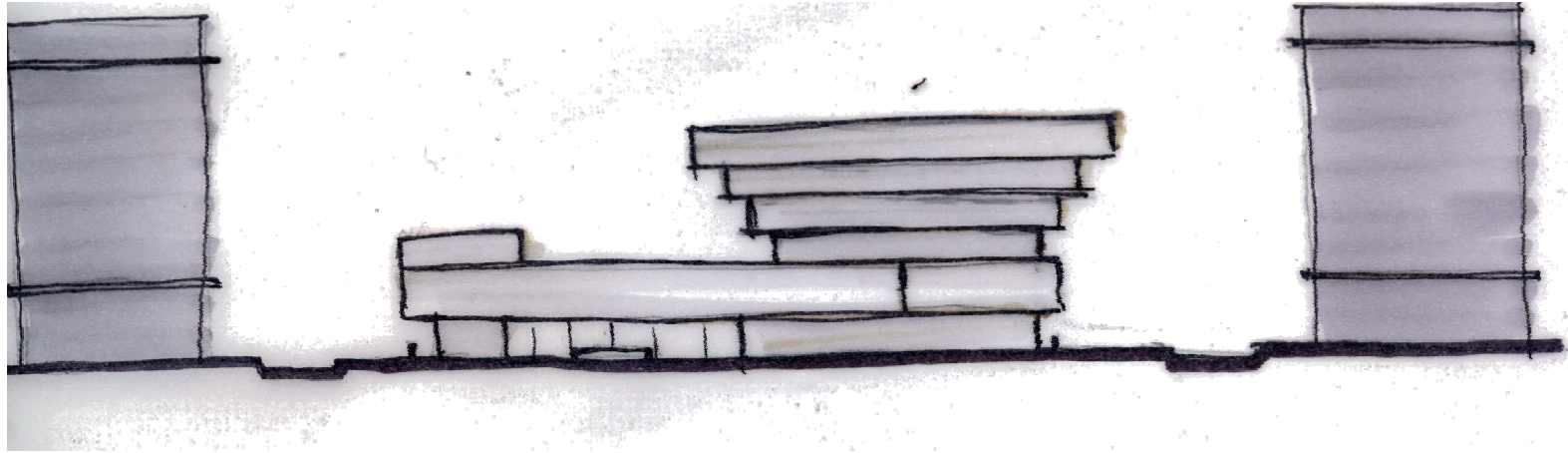


Form of the circulation space
